Matters Arising:

50-0717 **Red Telephone Box** – Notice asking for parishioners suggestions and ideas for the use of the box will be in the August edition of The Sheaf. Notices are also displayed in both Barsham and Shipmeadow PC notice boards, inside the Village Hall and the telephone box. Councillors discussed necessary replacement parts and general refurbishment work to the box.

51-0717 **Footpath 14, Clarkes Lane, Barsham** – Email received from Suffolk County Council. A replacement has been logged to the contractors schedule for when he is next in the area; this may take several weeks.

52-0717 **50mph Speed Limit B1062 Beccles to Bungay** – The comments in the previous minutes (49-0617) were made before the new speed limit order came into effect on 30th June 2017; new signs were painted on the B1062 road surface the day after the June PC meeting. Councillors will monitor the situation.

53-0717 Planning Matters:
